





Progressive (current) or traditional dispensationalism

dispensationalism

Progressive and traditional dispensationalists hold to many common beliefs, including views that are uniquely dispensational. The vast majority of adherents in both schools hold to a distinction between Israel and the Church, [2]:49-51 a future pre-tribulation rapture, [2]:317 a seven-year tribulation, and a Millennial Kingdom [2]:54-56 in which the rule of Jesus Christ will be centered in Jerusalem. Progressive dispensationalists tend to de-emphasize the pre-tribulation rapture doctrine, and same loop toward the next tribulation renture
