Notes

Weekday services are in St. David's Chapel. The lessons appointed for weekday Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer during the weeks following the second and third Sundays of Eastertide may be found on pages xxii & xxiii of the Book of Common Prayer. Readings for the Office (Morning & Evening Prayer) of St. Mark, as well as for the Office of Ss. Philip & James may be found on pages xlv and xlvi. Propers for Holy Communion of St. Mark begin on p. 237; those for Holy Communion of Ss. Philip & James on p. 238. April 25 is also, according to very ancient tradition, the Major Rogation, which our Prayer Book calls a day of "solemn supplication." It is thus a good day to pray the Litany (p. 541). The abbreviations after the names of saints signify: M, martyr; Ev, evangelist; Ap, apostle; B, bishop; C, confessor; and D, doctor (meaning teacher).
