Weekday services are in St. David's Chapel. The lessons appointed for weekday Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer during the weeks following the third and fourth Sundays of Eastertide may be found on pages xxii - xxv of the Book of Common Prayer. Readings for the Office (Morning & Evening Prayer) of Ss. Philip & James may be found on pages xlv and xlv; and propers for Holy Communion of Ss. Philip & James on p. 238. The abbreviations after the names of saints signify: Ap, apostle; B, bishop; C, confessor; and D, doctor (meaning teacher). The feast of the Invention (finding) of the Holy Cross is one of the commemorations found in the Calendar of the English Prayer Book of 1662, the basis for the American Prayer Book of 1928.
